Awards, Prizes & Scholarships are pursuant to UPHA Ribbons Of Service Rules For 2009 Season, excerpted as follows: Awards, Prizes and Scholarships. Minimum fundraising amount and community service hours are required to be eligible to win awards, prizes or scholarships. An award will be given to participating saddleseat equitation riders who raise the most funds while participating in saddleseat equitation classes at horse shows; the award is available for participants in each of four equine breeds (American Saddlebreds, Morgans, Arabians/Half-Arabians, or National Show Horses). An overall award will be given to the participant who raises the most funds of all participants in the UPHA Ribbons Of Service program. In the event of a tie created by two or more participants having raised an equal amount of funds, the participant with the highest number of community service hours (as accepted by UPHA) will be selected as the winner. Awards may be accompanied by prizes and/or scholarships, which may change from time to time, and are provided by donors of the UPHA Ribbons Of Service program and UPHA. A listing of available awards, prizes, scholarships and donors will be available by request from UPHA. Scholarships will be paid according to rules established by UPHA; payments are subject to recipient's submission to UPHA of allowable expenses incurred for higher education. No prize will be given until a tax identification number is provided by recipient. Prize recipients are responsible for payment of any taxes due thereon.
